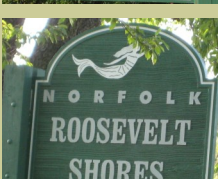

Lots going on up and down Little Creek Road but one of the biggest announcements this summer has been that Centura College will be buying the Calvary Revival School and using it for their students. At this time it will not replace the one located at Johnstons Road at Military Highway, but will be used primarily as their skilled training curriculum classrooms. We are excited to have them as our neighbors!

WE ARE A GOLF CART COMMUNITY

City Council voted in 2013 to recognize us as a golf cart community. The boundaries are Mona Avenue, Dominion Avenue and Meadowcreek Road.

Residents are required to adhere to the following city code:

Sec. 25-322. Limitations on golf cart operations on designated highways

- (a) A golf cart may be operated only on designated public highways where the posted speed limit is twenty-five (25) miles per hour or less. No golf cart shall cross any highway at an intersection where the highway being crossed has a posted speed limit of more than twenty-five (25) miles per hour.
- (b) No person shall operate any golf cart on any public highway unless he has in his possession a valid driver's license.
- (c) Every golf cart, whenever operated on a public highway, shall display a slow-moving vehicle emblem in conformity with section 46.2-1081, Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended and
- (d) Golf carts shall be operated upon the public highways only between sunrise and sunset, unless equipped with such lights as are required in sections 46.2-1010 et seq., Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, for different classes of vehicles.
